HARVEY HOMECOMING: The Gatemen have welcomed home a familiar face in new field manager Harvey Shapiro. Shapiro, who served as an assistant coach with the Gatemen for two seasons in the early nineties, was hired as the team's new field manager on August 27, 2021. After leaving Wareham, Shapiro would go on to manage Falmouth for five seasons, before leading the Bourne Braves for the next eighteen seasons. With 532 career wins, Shapiro sits third in all-timevwins in the CCBL. Shapiro is a member of the CCBL Hall of Fame 2020 class.

SWAN SONG: Through his first two appearances with Wareham, right-handed pitcher Eriq Swan has cruised past his competition. With outings against Orleans and Chatham, Swan has totaled 5.0 innings pitched while allowing just two hits, one by each opponent, and one walk to three strikeouts. At 6'6" and 240 pounds, the sophomore from Middle Tennessee State tossed 52.0 innings for the Blue Raiders this spring, while fanning 44 batters.

IT RUNS IN THE FAMILY: For pitcher Wyatt Hudepohl, athleticism can be found across his family tree. While Wyatt just concluded his second season with the Kentucky Wildcats, his sister, Sophia, looks towards her own second season playing volleyball at Lipscomb University. On the international scale, Hudepohl's uncle, Joe Hudepohl, lays claim to three Olympic medals in swimming. Of his three medals, he won gold during both the 1992 Summer Olympic Games in Barcelona, Spain and later during the 1996 Games in Atlanta, Georgia.

WINDISH'S WICKED START: The reigning SoCon Player of the Year is picking up right where he left off through eight games with the Gatemen. UNC Greensboro's Hogan Windish leads the team with a .321 batting average, which includes at least one hit in all but one game this summer. Windish also leads the entire CCBL with four doubles, and also in a less cheerful catagory with four hit-by-pitches.

WRIGHT GOES WAY BACK: For the first time with Wareham, Blake Wright was able to take a jog around the bases as he connected on his first home run this season in Monday's Game 1 loss at Chatham. His two-run blast found its way into the trees in left-center field of Veterans Field. Wright looks to build on an outstanding sophomore campaign with the Clemson Tigers that earned him All-ACC Third Team honors. After hitting just .167 as a true freshman, Wright more than doubled his batting average to .349, which included 11 home runs and 40 RBI.

FARROW REWRITES HISTORY: In just his sophomore season, Ian Farrow left his mark on the record books at Florida Gulf Coast. While hitting for a .322 average, Farrow mashed a single-season program record 21 home runs to pair with a record-breaking 75 runs batted in. The Merritt Island, FL native will look to continue his offensive successes in the ACC next spring as he announced his intentions to transfer to University of Miami (FL) on June 8.

ANDERSON'S NEW GROOVE: Despite a slow start to the 2022 CCBL season, Wareham infielder Max Anderson has turned over a new leaf and now owns a six-game on-base streak entering Tuesday's matchup with Cotuit. After being named the Big Ten Freshman of the Year and a Collegiate Baseball Freshman All-American in 2021, Anderson continued to make his presence known across his 2022 campaign. He started all 53 games at Nebraska and led the team in hits (67), home runs (10), and RBI (45). The Omaha, NE native will aim to replicate his stellar season outside his home state as he joins the Gatemen for the 2022 summer.
