HARVEY HOMECOMING: The Gatemen have welcomed home a familiar face in new field manager Harvey Shapiro. Shapiro, who served as an assistant coach with the Gatemen for two seasons in the early nineties, was hired as the team's new field manager on August 27, 2021. After leaving Wareham, Shapiro would go on to manage Falmouth for five seasons, before leading the Bourne Braves for the next eighteen seasons. With 533 career wins, Shapiro sits third in all-time wins in the CCBL. Shapiro is a member of the CCBL Hall of Fame 2020 class.

WINDISH'S WICKED START: The reigning SoCon Player of the Year is picking up right where he left off through 11 games with the Gatemen. UNC Greensboro's Hogan Windish leads the team with a .350 batting average, which includes at least one hit in all but one game this summer. Windish also leads the entire CCBL with five doubles, and also in a less cheerful category with five hit-by-pitches.

ANDERSON'S NEW GROOVE: Despite a slow start to the 2022 CCBL season, Wareham infielder Max Anderson has turned over a new leaf and now owns a eight-game on-base streak entering Saturday's matchup at Falmouth. After being named the Big Ten Freshman of the Year and a Collegiate Baseball Freshman All-American in 2021, Anderson continued to make his presence known across his 2022 campaign. He started all 53 games at Nebraska and led the team in hits (67), home runs (10), and RBI (45). The Omaha, NE native will aim to replicate his stellar season outside his home state as he joins the Gatemen for the 2022 summer.

SWAN SONG: Through his first two appearances with Wareham, right-handed pitcher Eriq Swan has cruised past his competition. With outings against Orleans and Chatham, Swan has totaled 5.0 innings pitched while allowing just two hits, one by each opponent, and one walk to three strikeouts. At 6'6" and 240 pounds, the sophomore from Middle Tennessee State tossed 52.0 innings for the Blue Raiders this spring, while fanning 44 batters.

WESTON MAKES IT LOOK EASY: For his second outing of the 2022 CCBL season, Michigan right-hander Cameron Weston dominated the Harwich Mariners on Wednesday night. After surrendering his only hit allowed to the first batter he faced, Weston would go on to retire the next 11 batters. Earning his second win of the summer, Weston's final line was: 4.0 innings pitched, one hit, no runs allowed with no walks and three strikeouts. In his postgame interview with Wareham's Claire Foley, Weston was asked which of his pitches were working best for him against the Mariners, and he simply replied, "All of them."

WRIGHT GOES WAY BACK: For the first time with Wareham, Blake Wright was able to take a jog around the bases as he connected on his first home run this season on Monday. In Game 1 of the doubleheader at Chatham, Wright's two-run blast found its way into the trees in left-center field of Veterans Field. Wright looks to build on an outstanding sophomore campaign with the Clemson Tigers that earned him All-ACC Third Team honors. After hitting just .167 as a true freshman, Wright more than doubled his batting average to .349, which included 11 home runs and 40 RBI.

IT RUNS IN THE FAMILY: For pitcher Wyatt Hudepohl, athleticism can be found across his family tree. While Wyatt just concluded his second season with the Kentucky Wildcats, his sister, Sophia, looks towards her own second season playing volleyball at Lipscomb University. On the international scale, Hudepohl's uncle, Joe Hudepohl, lays claim to three Olympic medals in swimming. Of his three medals, he won gold during both the 1992 Summer Olympic Games in Barcelona, Spain and later during the 1996 Games in Atlanta, Georgia.
