HARVEY HOMECOMING: The Gatemen have welcomed home a familiar face in new field manager Harvey Shapiro. Shapiro, who served as an assistant coach with the Gatemen for two seasons in the early nineties, was hired as the team's new field manager on August 27, 2021. After leaving Wareham, Shapiro would go on to manage Falmouth for five seasons, before leading the Bourne Braves for the next eighteen seasons. With 535 career wins, Shapiro sits third in all-timevwins in the CCBL. Shapiro is a member of the CCBL Hall of Fame 2020 class.

EVANS ELEVATES: Over his last three games, Florida's Ty Evans has gone 6-11 at-the-plate with a home run and four RBIs. In Tuesday's 6-4 victory over Falmouth, Evans bashed a go-ahead three-run homer off the left field concession stand, his first shot of the season. The native of Auburndale, Florida hit .242 in 35 games for the Florida Gators as a true freshman. His 2022 campaign also included five home runs. Evans is hitting .273 through six games with the Gatemen, and brings a three-game hit streak into Thursday's matchup at Cotuit.

NO NEED TO WORRY: For the second straight game, the Gatemen utilized a big offensive frame as their spark for a comeback win. In Game Two of Sunday's doubleheader against Harwich, a grand slam from Ryan Campos capped off a six-run second inning that initially erased a two-run deficit, en route to a 6-5 Wareham win. Following an off-day, the Gatemen looked to battle-back once again, this time against Falmouth. A five-run sixth, highlighted by Ty Evans' three-run blast, led to the Gatemen's 6-4 victory over the Commodores.

PINCH HITTING POWER: For the first time this season, a member of the Gatemen connected on a pinch-hit home run in Wednesday's loss to Brewster. In the eighth inning, Connecticut's Bryan Padilla lifted a leadoff homer to left field, his first longball of the summer. Padilla started 60 of 61 games this spring for the Huskies and hit .282 with 15 doubles, two triples, and eight home runs with 37 RBI.

SWAN SONG: Through his first three appearances with Wareham, right-handed pitcher Eriq Swan has cruised past his competition. With outings against Orleans, Chatham, and Falmouth Swan has totaled 8.0 innings pitched while allowing just four hits, and one walk to 11 strikeouts. At 6'6" and 240 pounds, the sophomore from Middle Tennessee State tossed 52.0 innings for the Blue Raiders this spring, while fanning 44 batters.

WINDISH'S WICKED START: The reigning SoCon Player of the Year is picking up right where he left off through 16 games with the Gatemen. UNC Greensboro's Hogan Windish has been one of the best bats for Wareham posting a .310 batting average, which includes at least one hit in all but three games this summer. Windish also is tied for the CCBL lead with five doubles, and also in a less cheerful catagory with five hit-by-pitches.

IT RUNS IN THE FAMILY: For pitcher Wyatt Hudepohl, athleticism can be found across his family tree. While Wyatt just concluded his second season with the Kentucky Wildcats, his sister, Sophia, looks towards her own second season playing volleyball at Lipscomb University. On the international scale, Hudepohl's uncle, Joe Hudepohl, lays claim to three Olympic medals in swimming. Of his three medals, he won gold during both the 1992 Summer Olympic Games in Barcelona, Spain and later during the 1996 Games in Atlanta, Georgia.
