**HARVEY HOMECOMING:** The Gatemen have welcomed home a familiar face in new field manager Harvey Shapiro. Shapiro, who served as an assistant coach with the Gatemen for two seasons in the early nineties, was hired as the team's new field manager on August 27, 2021. After leaving Wareham, Shapiro would go on to manage Falmouth for five seasons, before leading the Bourne Braves for the next eighteen seasons. With 529 career wins, Shapiro sits third in all-time wins in the CCBL. Shapiro is a member of the CCBL Hall of Fame 2020 class.

**JUST WHERE HE LEFT OFF:** In his first start of the 2022 CCBL season, Jonathan Brand continued to shine from the mound, much like he did this past spring at Miami (OH). The NCAA Division I ERA leader took to the bump against the Bourne Braves on Monday and tossed 5.0 scoreless innings while allowing just one hit. He would nearly match Michael Sansone's Opening Day start of six strikeouts, as Brand fanned 5 Braves' batters.

**MAXIMUM IMPACT:** After being named the Big Ten Freshman of the Year and a Collegiate Baseball Freshman All-American in 2021, Nebraska's Max Anderson continued to make his presence known across his 2022 campaign. Anderson started all 53 games for the Cornhuskers and led the team in hits (67), home runs (10), and RBI (45). The Omaha, NE native will aim to replicate his stellar season outside his home state as he joins the Gatemen for the 2022 summer.

**IT RUNS IN THE FAMILY:** For pitcher Wyatt Hudepohl, athleticism can be found across his family tree. While Wyatt just concluded his second season with the Kentucky Wildcats, his sister, Sophia, looks towards her own second season playing volleyball at Lipscomb University. On the international scale, Hudepohl's uncle, Joe Hudepohl, lays claim to three Olympic medals in swimming. Of his three medals, he won gold during both the 1992 Summer Olympic Games in Barcelona, Spain and later during the 1996 Games in Atlanta, Georgia.

**TIME IS WRIGHT:** After hitting just .167 over the course of his freshman season, Blake Wright had a complete offensive turnaround as a sophomore for the Clemson Tigers. Garnering Third Team All-ACC honors, Wright more than doubled his batting average to .349 that included 11 home runs and 40 RBI.

**NEAR PERFECTION:** Today's Wareham starting pitcher, Indiana State junior righty Matt Jachec, flirted with history in his outing against Valparaiso earlier this spring on May 25. After eight innings on the mound, Jachec had totaled 10 strikeouts without allowing a single baserunner. Unfortunately, Jachec surrendered a single to leadoff the ninth frame but still set a new career-high for innings (8.0) and recorded 10 punchouts for the second time in 2022.

**NOTHIN' BUT A HOUND DOG:** California catcher, Cole Elvis, notched the first multi-hit game of the early summer for the Gatemen in Monday's tie against Bourne. The Vacaville, California native finished 2-3 at the plate while catching all nine frames. In his third consecutive season as the Golden Bears primary catcher, Elvis started all 56 games and set new career highs in hits (59), RBIs (41), runs scored (24), and walks drawn (27). Meanwhile, he posted a .266 batting average with 17 doubles, one triple, and three home runs.

**DOUBLES AND DINKS:** Through his first two games with the Gatemen, UNC-Greensboro senior Hogan Windish has oddly totaled the same number of doubles and hit-by-pitches with two in each category. On Sunday, Windish's RBI double tied the game with Hyannis in the seventh inning and Windish himself would later come around to score the eventual game-winning run in the Gatemen's 2-1 victory. Then, on Monday against Bourne, the reigning Southern Conference Player of the Year rocked his second double off the left field fence. Later in the game, Windish would be hit twice by Bourne pitchers.

**FARROW'S SWING GOES FAR:** In just his sophomore season, Ian Farrow left his mark on the record books at Florida Gulf Coast. While hitting for a .322 average, Farrow mashed a single-season program record 21 home runs to pair with a record-breaking 75 runs batted in. The Merritt Island, FL native will look to continue his offensive successes in the ACC next spring as he announced his intentions to transfer to University of Miami (FL) on June 8.
