



Coach Development Internship – Wareham Gatemen (Wareham, MA)

Summary: The Wareham Gatemen Organization is looking for four (4) Coach Development interns who will be primarily responsible for assisting the Coaching Staff with day-to-day tasks. The position will run from June 2023 – August 2023 (or end of season, including playoffs). Exact dates TBD.

Reports to: Field Manager

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Attend all Gatemen games.
- Assist coaching staff with on and off field duties; throwing BP, hitting fungos, working with machines, field maintenance, field prep, charting games, monitoring bus schedule and post-game meal schedule, monitoring community relations schedules, etc.
- Maintain cleanliness of players' club house, coach's room, batting cages and training room.
- Responsible for grounds crew duties (compensation provided for doing team laundry or field work done not in the regular course of a day of baseball practice/games).
- Any other tasks Field Manager requires, including catching bullpens.

A Note on Baseball Related Duties and Restrictions:

The Coach Development interns should have a desire to pursue a career coaching in collegiate or professional baseball. The chosen applicants will get firsthand exposure to the fundamentals of coaching for each position and working with the top collegiate players. Each intern will work with all position coaches. This is not a specialization position. It is important to get exposure to all positions. There will be catching bullpens on a daily basis throughout the summer.

This position is a great opportunity to learn from a very experienced and knowledgeable coaching staff and to develop a foundation which you can build upon your entire coaching career.

Qualifications:

- **The ability to catching bullpens safely is strongly preferred and will move an applicant to the top of the list.**
- Former/current collegiate or professional playing experience (baseball/softball) is preferred.
- Advanced baseball knowledge required.
- Professional attitude and work ethic with strong interpersonal skills.
- Previous work with a professional / college baseball/softball program preferred.
- The ideal candidate must be willing to work long hours, including days, nights, weekends and holidays.

Additional Information & Expectations:

- Must be able to provide own transportation to away games in case it is needed.
- Housing is not provided but the Gatemen can assist in finding appropriate housing (approximate rental costs \$2,750/person for the entire summer)
- Adhere to the Wareham Gatemen organization policies and procedures as well as the Cape Cod Baseball League Code of Conduct.
